KNOW ALL MEN TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

THAT Isaac B Noble having served faithfully and honorably for the term of fourteen months from the Sixth day of September 1836 until the twenty fourth day of November 1837 and being honorably discharged from the Army of Texas is entitled to 100 Acres of Land for Acres Bounty Land, for which this is his Certificate.

And the said Isaac B Noble is entitled to hold said Land, or to sell, alienate, convey and donate the same, and exercise all rights of ownership over it.

This Certificate will be transferable by Endorsement, with a Deed, before any competent authority, with witnesses to the same.

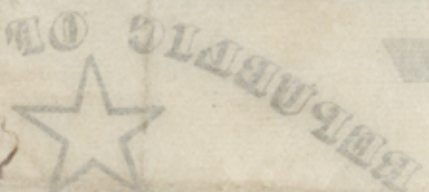

of this City. present and accepting and who hereby ack-
nowledges possession thereof, all his Right, Title and
interest in and to Six Hundred and forty acres of
Bounty Land. granted to him by the Republic of Texas,
per Certificate of Barnard G. Bee. Secretary of War
Numbered Five Hundred and Eight. dated the twenty
fifth. day of November Eighteen Hundred and thirty
Seven, together with all the Rights and privileges there-
unto belonging.

And the said Isaac B. Noble. hereby author-
izes and empowers the said Dudley Starke or his Substitute
to fulfil all the engagements required by Law, for the com-
pletion of the aforesaid Bounty or Donation and for
that purpose to appear before all courts or Public Func-
tionaries, and sign execute all acts for the ratification
and confirmation thereof.

To Have and To Hold the aforesaid
County Land unto the said purchaser to his proper
use and behoof forever, and the said Vendor for
himself his heirs and assigns unto the said pur-
chaser his heirs and assigns the herein described
County Land against the legal claim and claims
of all and every person and persons whomsoever
shall and will forever warrant and defend
by these presents. hereby Subrogating and trans-
ferring unto said purchaser all his Rights of war-
rant and action against this Vendor and all
preceding Vendors.
