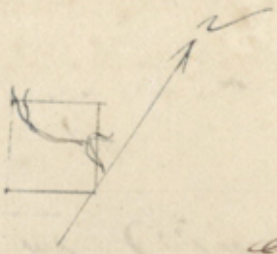

Phel A. Sterns of this Republic present and purchasing for himself, his heirs, and assigns, One third of a League of land granted as a head right by the laws of this Republic to Isaac H. Bear by his assignee John Belding of this County as appears by the Certificate of the Board of Land Commissioners of this County number fifty four. Also. One third of a league of land granted as a head right to George Island by his assignee John Belding as aforesaid, as appears by the Certificate of the said Board of Land Commissioners number three hundred and fifty five

Also One third of a league of Land granted
in the same manner to George Webster by
his attorney John Beldin as aforesaid as
appears by the certificate of the said Board of
Land Commissioners Number three hundred and
fifty four, all of which are well outd, and
subject to be located on any unappropriated
land of this Republic at any time the owner
thereof shall choose to do the same having been
all acquired by right of residence in the
Republic before the declaration of independence

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD The said *Headsrights*
unto the said *Purchaser* his Heirs and Assigns, to their

proper use, benefit and behoof, forever. And the said *John Bel-*
dine for himself _____ and his
Heirs the same right which he hath to the said *Christopher H Sterns*
his Heirs and Assigns, shall and will warrant, and forever defend against the
lawful claims of all persons whomsoever, by these presents. And the said Vendor
doth moreover subrogate the said Purchaser to all the rights and actions of war-
ranty which he hath or may have, against his own Vendor & or
against the Vendors of his Vendors, fully authorizing the said Purchaser
to exercise the said rights and actions in the same manner as he himself
might or could have done.

And the said *John Beldine*
declares that he has held the said
headsrights by virtue of a purchase
of each of the Original holders and
he the said *Beldin* sells and transfers
the same right which he acquired by
virtue of said purchases, to the said
Sterns with all the powers of locating
and perfecting a title which he him-
self professes. he this purchaser
