That M. A. Bingham — having served faithfully and honorably for the term of Three Months from the Fifth day of March until the Fifth day of June 1836 and having been honorably discharged from the Army is entitled to Three hundred twenty Acres Bounty Land, for which this is his CERTIFICATE.

And the said M. A. Bingham
is entitled to hold said Land, or to sell, alienate, convey and donate the same, and to exercise all rights of ownership over it.
