Bingham* having served faithfully and honorably for the term of *Three* Months from the *Fifth* day of *March* until the *Fifth* day of *June* 1836 and having been honorably discharged from the Army is entitled to *Three hundred twenty* Acres Bounty Land, for which this is his CERTIFICATE.

And the said *M. A. Bingham* is entitled to hold said Land, or to sell, alienate, convey and donate the same, and to exercise all rights of ownership over it.

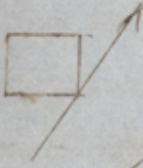


