This is to Certify, that *John Setcher* ^{by his atty John Piddan} has appeared before us, the BOARD OF LAND COMMISSIONERS FOR THE COUNTY OF HARRISBURG, and proved according to law, that he arrived in this country in February Eighteen hundred thirty six and that he is a Single man and entitled to *One third of a League of LAND*, upon the condition of paying at the rate of *Five dollars* for every labor of irrigable land, *three dollars and fifty cents* for every labor of temporal or arable land, *two dollars and forty cents* for every labor of pasture land, which may be contained in the Survey secured to him by this Certificate.

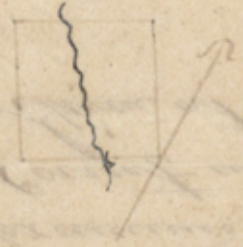
