This is to certify, That *Hugh Kennedy* has appeared before us, the Board of Land Commissioners, for the county aforesaid, and proved according to law, that he arrived in this Republic in *December*, one thousand eight hundred and *forty five*; that he is a single man and having never received a certificate for the quantity of land for which he applies, he is entitled to a conditional grant of *Three Hundred Thirty* acres of land, in accordance with an Act of Congress, approved *January 4th*, 1841.

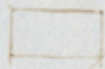
