moving, have this day nominated, constituted, and ap-  
pointed, and do hereby constitute and appoint Jacob  
De Cordova my Attorney and Attorney in fact, do re-  
mand and receive of the Government of the State of Tex-  
as, all such certificates for lands as may be entitled  
to under the laws of Texas, as heir of Alanson  
Arms who was a soldier in the Texan war of Inde-  
pendence, or to recover said certificates from any person  
whomsoever having possession of the same, if they have  
been issued, heretofore; to locate said certificates, and  
to cause the lands to be surveyed, and returns of said  
surveys to be made according to law, and to obtain Pa-  
tents for me as heir, as aforesaid for the same.  
Or if said Certificates have been heretofore located and  
the lands surveyed, and not patented, or if patents  
have been issued, then my Attorney is hereby autho-  
rized to institute suit or suits in my name for the recov-  
ery of said lands, and in my name to sell and as-  
sign said certificates, or to sell and convey said lands as  
the case may be. And further he the said Attorney is  
hereby fully empowered to do all and every act necessary  
to recover for me all such land certificates or other title.
