for every Labor of Inhabitable Land Two  
Dollars  $\frac{50}{100}$  for every Labor of Temporal  
or Arable Land one dollar  $\frac{20}{100}$  for every  
Labor of Pasture Land which may be  
contained in the survey to him by this cer-  
tificate said William having assigned this certificate

 bears S. 5° W. 1 1/2 y. Thence S. 60° W. at 1993 y set a

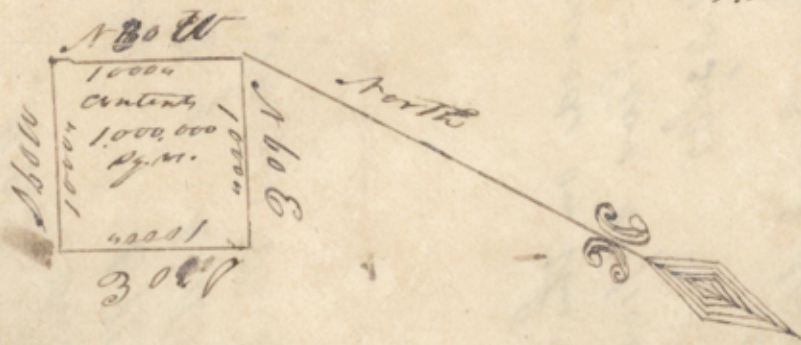
