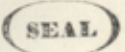
of the second part, WITNESSETH: That for and in consideration of the sum of Sixty  
Dollars in hand paid by the part y of the second part to the part y of the first  
part, the receipt of which is hereby fully acknowledged and confessed, the said part y of the first part, by this act, has granted, bargained, sold,  
conveyed and released, and doth hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and release unto the said part y of the second part, his heirs, assigns and  
legal representatives, the following described land and premises, lying and being situated in the County of Bosque in the State of Texas.

To wit: Eighty acres of Land situated in Scrip Out of Lance Scrip No 7209 due  
January 13th 1863 which was issued to me as the Assignee said Eighty Acres be  
ing the same portion as was located by N B Scott on the Headwaters of Childers  
Creek and known as Survey No 1044 for a more particular identification of said  
scrip reference is hereby made to file 818 Main Scrip

Together with all and singular the rights, members, improvements, hereditaments and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any wise incident or  
appertaining, and the reversions and remainders, rents, issues and profits thereof. **To have and to hold** all and singular the premises and here-  
ditaments above mentioned and hereby and herein granted, with the appurtenances thereto belonging, to the said part y of the second part, his heirs  
and assigns, to the only proper use and behoof of the said part y of the second part, his heirs and assigns for ever. And the said part y of the first  
part by this act bind himself his heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the said herein before  
described premises unto the said part y of the second part, his heirs and assigns, against every person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to  
claim the same, or any part thereof.
