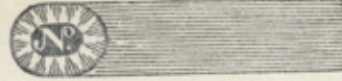

Tobin dec'd by his _____ appeared before us, and proved according to Law that he emigrated to Texas previous to the 2^d March 1836. rec'd a cert. for $\frac{1}{3}$ league from the Board of Land Comm^rs of Harrisburg County. dated Feb'y 8. 1838. & that the record of the issuance thereof was lost at the time of the visit of the Investigating board, and proof of its genuineness having been made to us according to the requisitions of an act for the relief of J. S. Black and others -

This is therefore to declare that the said Nathl. J. Tobin dec'd by his _____ is entitled to an Unconditional Headright of one third of a league of land acres, by virtue of his emigration, and the above described Certificate heretofore issued.
