Before me, the undersigned, District Clerk in and for the County aforesaid, this ^{day} came and personally appeared J H Lee a resident citizen of said County, who being by me duly sworn, declareth that he is a bona fide settler upon one hundred and fifty (150) acres of vacant public land, situated in said County, and surveyed for J H Lee on the 1st day of February 1873 by L H Scutchfield a Surveyor of said County; that he has occupied and improved the same as a Homestead for a period of three consecutive years, beginning on the 28th day of February 1870 that he is a married man and makes this affidavit for the purpose of obtaining a title to the same for a Homestead under the ~~Act supplementary to~~ "An act for the benefit of actual Occupants of the Public Lands," approved May 26th 1873, and acts pur therev; and that he has no a Homestead other than the above.

And also at the same time came and personally appeared F M Gandy and G M Lorkey, two credible residents

citizens of said County to me well
known, who being duly sworn, depos-
ses and says that J. H. Lee the person
first above named in this affidavit,
has actually settled upon and cultivated
as a Homestead, the land surveyed for
him on the 4th day of February 1836 by
the Surveyor aforesaid, for the period of
