That Joseph Dennis (Bullocks Co.) having entered into the SERVICE OF TEXAS, and fallen with Fannin at Goliad his Heirs are entitled to One Third League of LAND, as the **HEAD-RIGHT** of said Joseph Dennis under the provisions of an act of the Legislature, approved February 9th, 1850. And the said heirs are entitled to hold said Land and exercise all rights of ownership over the same.

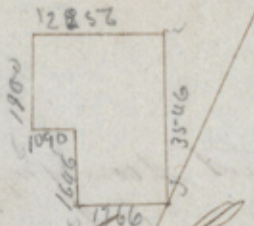
