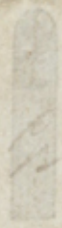

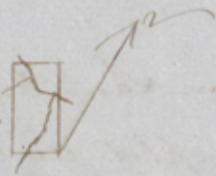

in paid by the said Catherine Wescott has bargain
Sold & conveyed and by these presents does bargain
Sell and convey to her the said Catherine Wescott
my unconditional Head rights Certificate No 70
issued by the Board of Said Commissioners of Gal-
veston County on 21st August 1844 for three hundred
and twenty acres of Land. The Conditional Certificate
being No 64. ^{Geo} Clap. And the said Reines
hereby further bargains sells & conveys to the said
C Wescott the Tract of Land surveyed by virtue
of said Certificate on the Head of Clark Creek
Lake to her the said Catherine Wescott her heirs
and assigns forever. To have and to hold said
Certificate and the Land surveyed by virtue
thereof or which may hereafter be surveyed to
her the said Catherine Wescott, her heirs and
assigns forever. And the said Reines hereby
warrants and defends this title to the same for
himself, his heirs &c &c. And he moreover hereby
authorises, empowers & requires the Commissioners
of the General Land to issue patent for the
said surveyed as aforesaid or which may
hereafter be surveyed by virtue of said
Certificate to her the said Catherine
Wescott her heirs and assigns
