

Before me, the undersigned J. M. Collier Clerk in and for the County aforesaid, this day came and personally appeared L. H. Nordenhauq, a resident citizen of said County, who being by me duly sworn, declares that he is a bona fide settler upon 160 acres of vacant public land, situated in said County, and surveyed for L. H. Nordenhauq, on the 28th day of March 1873 by S. W. Dennefield Deputy Surveyor of said County; that he has occupied and improved the same as a Homestead for a period of three consecutive years, beginning on the 28th day of March 1873 that he is Married man and that he makes affidavit for the purpose of obtaining a title to the same for a Homestead, under an Act supplementary to "An Act for the Benefit of Actual Occupants of the Public Lands," approved May 26th, 1873, and Acts prior thereto; and that he has not a Homestead other than the above.

AND also at the same time came and personally appeared, L. O. Strand and Gilbert Olsen, two credible resident citizens of said County, to me well known, who being duly sworn, depose and say that L. H. Nordenhauq, the person first above named in this Affidavit; has actually settled upon and cultivated as a Homestead, the land surveyed for him on the 23rd day of March 1880 by the Surveyor aforesaid, for the period of three years, and they nor either of them have any interest in the said land.

Report of the Surveyor resurveying the L. H. Hauderhang
Emmett's Pre-emption Survey of Bosque Co.

The original field notes of this Survey began at the S.E. Cor.
of the A. Irling's pre-emption which according to the testimony
of L' Hause & O.A. Hause the two original chain carriers was a
mistake in the call. 440^{10} N 30° E of this corner I found an
old rock pile several years ago when surveying the H. H.
Johnson for the Plum Brothers of Galveston for corrected field
notes & reports and wished said Johnson to conform to
this line rather than the call. On this Survey I found
said pile of rocks or rather L' Hause above alluded to carried
me to this as the beginning corner of the L.H. Hauderhang.
From this I ran N 60° E- 680^{10} distance called for & 682^{10} found
old rock pile. Hence N 30° W- 690^{10} found rock pile & Hause
sons field fenced to same point. Hence N 60° E to be
gaining finding all the corners as called for & in conflict
with nothing else on the contiguous surveys.
