KNOW ALL MEN TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

THAT *William Winkler* having served faithfully and honorably for the term of *Twelve* months from the *Tenth* day of *October 1836* until the *fourth* day of *November 1837* and being honorably discharged from the *Army of Texas* is entitled to *Six hundred & forty* Acres Bounty Land, for which this is his Certificate.

And the said *William Winkler* is entitled to hold said Land, or to sell, alienate, convey and donate the same, and to exercise all rights of ownership over it.

This Certificate will be transferable by Endorsement, with a Deed, before any competent Authority, with Witnesses to the same.

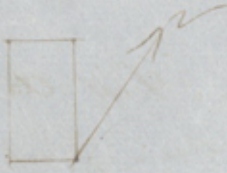

Know all men by these presents that I William Winkler (late a soldier) for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Robert Walker the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have this day bargained sold encoffed and conveyed, and by these presents do bargain, sell encoff and convey to said Robert Walker his heirs or assigns six hundred and forty acres of land, to be hereafter selected, located and surveyed when and where said Robert Walker may think fit and the laws will permit; which said land is coming to me for military services rendered as set forth in my certificate for bounty lands, dated 4th Nov. 1837 and signed Barnard E. Bee Secretary of war, with my name endorsed on the back thereof.

To have and to hold the aforesaid land and premises to him the said Robert Walker his heirs executors administrators or assigns in fee simple forever; and I do hereby warrant and defend the aforesaid land and premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever, and to be free of all manner of incumbrance whatever.

before me Amasa Busico, Chief Justice of the County,
and of office a Notary Public, duly commissioned and
sworn, personally came and appeared the within named

with him executed the within and made and endorsed the original
land certificate therein described, and testified that his
act might have all the faith and evidence, of a Notarial
act.
