of vacant public land, situated in said county, and surveyed for *Ole Wold* on the *25* day of *March* 1873 by *L. A. Scrutchedfield*

Surveyor of said county; that he has occupied and improved the same as a homestead for the period of three consecutive years, beginning on the *1* day of *June* 1863 that he is

now on said land and that he makes this affidavit for the purpose of obtaining

a title to the same for a homestead under ~~An Act supplementary to~~ "An Act for the benefit of actual occupants of the Public Lands," approved May 26, 1873, and that he has not a homestead other than the above.

And also at the same time came and personally appeared *Thomas A. Hammonds*

and *O. J. Johnson* two credible resident citizens of said county, to me well

known, who being duly sworn, depose and say that *Ole Wold* the person

first above named in this affidavit, has actually settled upon and cultivated as a homestead the land surveyed for him

on the *25* day of *March* 1873 by the Surveyor aforesaid, for the period of three

years, and they nor either of them have any interest in the said land.
