Know all men by these presents that we ^{James}
Mays and wife, Mrs. Mays wife of the said James
of the County of Bastrop and Republic of Texas for and in
consideration of the sum of six hundred dollars to us in
hand paid by W.D. Thompson &c. the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged. — have this day bargained, sold, Alimed, released,
Conveyed and Transferred and by these presents do all, alim,
release, Convey and confirm unto the aforesaid W.D. Thompson &c.
their heirs or assigns thirty three hundred and thirty three
acres or three fourths of a League of Land to which we are
entitled as citizens of this Republic, as will appear by
reference to a Land certificate issued by the Board of
Land Commissioners of the County of Bastrop aforesaid
on the 1st day of January 1838 - No 36 which certificate
is now in the possession of the said W.D. Thompson
&c. — And we authorize the said W.D. Thompson &c.
their heirs or assigns to locate the said land to which
we are so entitled in any part of the Republic that
they may deem proper, and to call upon the proper
officers of this Republic for the necessary title to
the same in their own proper name if the law will
so permit, and if the law will not so permit, then &
in that case, we bind ourselves our heirs and assigns
unto the said W.D. Thompson &c. their heirs or assigns
in the sum total sum of five thousand dollars to make

to them their heirs or assigns a Bonapoli or for simpler
title to the Land aforesaid, so long as we or either of us, or
our heirs or assigns may retain a title from this Govern-
ment to the same; — and we authorize the said W.D. Thom-
son &c^o their heirs or assigns to enter upon when located
said Land and to use and dispose of the same as their
own property acquired by a just & legal title — And
we declare that we have not hitherto sold, alined, mort-
gaged or in any ^{way} disposed of the Land aforesaid, and that
said claim is free from all incumbrances whatsoever;
as such we sell the same to the said W.D. Thomson &c^o
their heirs or assigns for the Consideration aforesaid;
and renounce all laws which might weaken or destroy
this obligation or any part thereof in favor of the
said Purchasers, their heirs or assigns.—
