of William Parvin, Deceased, are entitled to one third of a
League of Land, it having been proved according to Law
before us the Board of Land Commissioners for the County of
Matagorda that he Arrived in this Republic in the Month
of December, in the year Eighteen hundred and thirty five
and was a single Man, and entitled to the quantity of
Land specified for, upon conditions of paying at the rate
of five Dollars for every Labor of Arable Land and two
Dollars and forty cents for every Labor of Pasture Land
which may be contained in the Survey Surveyed to them
by this Certificate
