H bears S. 30 E. 31 varas and another marked
K bears N. 74 W. 30 varas thence N. 60 E. 1900
varas a stake for the N.E. corner of this
survey thence S. 30 E. 950 varas a
stake for the S. E. corner of this survey
thence S. 60 W. 1900 varas to the S.W.
corner from which a spanish oak marked L
bears N. 37 E. 30 varas and an Elm bears S. 46 W.
4 varas thence N. 30 W. 425 varas a bench
950 varas to the beginning.
