KNOW ALL MEN TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

That *Shadrach Gay* having served faithfully and honorably for the term of *Three* Months from the *Thirtieth* day of *June* until the *Thirtieth* day of *September 1836* and having been honorably discharged from the *Army* is entitled *Three hundred and twenty*

Acres Bounty Land, for which this is his CERTIFICATE.

And the said *Shadrach Gay* is entitled to hold said Land, or to sell, alienate, convey and donate the same, and to exercise all rights of ownership over it.

In Testimony Whereof, I have hereunto set my hand, at the City of Houston, this *17th* day of *Apr.* 1838




