privileges to actual settlers

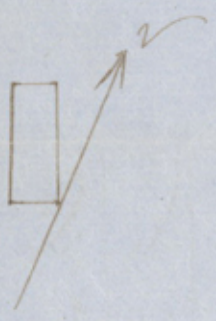

of Meridian west of Bayou and about 4 1/4 miles
S. 80 W. from Meridian.

Beginning 680 varas S 30 E from the N. E. corner of
a survey made for George G. Gary for the N. W.
corner of this survey from which a live oak marked
A bears S. 55 W. 9 varas thence S. 30 E. 2500 varas
to the S. W. corner a pile of rocks from which a
live oak marked W bears S. 62 E. 514 varas thence
N. 80 E. 720 varas to the S. E. corner a pile
of rocks from which an Elm marked M bears
N. 8 E. 4 varas thence N. 30 W. 2500 varas
to the N. E. corner from which an Elm
bears S. 63 E. 2 varas thence
S. 60 W. 420 varas to the place of beginning.
