The following is a copy of the original bill of lading of the ship "Alamot" dated July 13, 1838, showing the names of the consignees and the quantity of goods shipped. claimed by him as a resident citizen of Texas on the day of  
the date of the declaration of Independence, and for which a certi-  
ficate No. 505 was issued by the Board of Land Commissioners  
in & for said County on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of April 1838, but which  
said land has not yet been located.
