W. Allen &c. for One League and One labor of land, dated the Third day of May 1838.

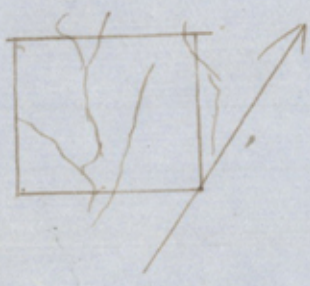

run from the S.E. corner of the Armstrong
Survey to the S.E. corner of the C.C. Supton
Survey thence N 30 W to the N.W. corner of
Jacob Green's Survey or spanish old marked V
N 44 W 45 W a direct marked W N 87 W
65' varas and from thence run 1900 varas
for the S.E. corner of Keyplett's Survey
I found the distance from across Armstrong
and Supton's survey 5600 varas which will
carry the East line of the Lednum Survey
18 varas N 60 E of the Eastern survey
and I therefore certify that there is
no conflict on the ground I know
from measurement the distance from
the S.E. corner of the Wm King Survey
to the N.E. corner of the Armstrong survey
