required by Law, and Ordered us to Issue to the said
John T. Eubanks and Charles White a Certificate for the
above One Third of a League of Land - Upon the Condition
of their paying at the rate of Three ⁵⁰/₁₀₀ dollars for every
labor of Irregular Land Two ⁵⁰/₁₀₀ dollars for every labor
of Arable or temporal Land and One ⁵⁰/₁₀₀ dollars for
every labor of Pasture Land which may be contained in
the Survey secured to them by this Certificate - Given
at our hands this 22 day of March 1838

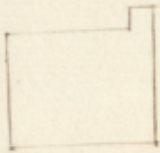

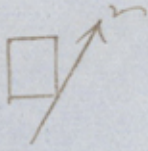
