Know all men by these presents,  
That I, William Haddon of the County aforesaid,  
for and in consideration of Twenty dollars (\$20.00) to me  
in hand paid to my full satisfaction, by Albert  
C. Horton of the said County, and State, have  
bargained, sold and conveyed, and do by these presents,  
grant, sell, convey and transfer unto him the said  
Albert C. Horton, all my right title, and interest  
in and to a certain land certificate, for three  
hundred and twenty acres of bounty land, granted  
by the State of Texas to William Haddon, for having  
served in the Army of the Republic of Texas, three  
months, as will more fully appear by reference to the  
Land Certificate, Number four hundred and ninety-  
-nine (499) which bears date Austin January 29<sup>th</sup>  
1849, signed by John D. Pitts Adjutant General,  
who drew it in my favor, & which Certificate  
is made a part and parcel of this deed.  
To have and to hold to him the said Horton, his  
heirs & assigns in pure & absolute property.  
In testimony of all which I have hereunto set  
my hand & seal, this tenth day of May A.D. one thou-  
-and eight hundred and forty nine, using a scroll  
for a seal.
