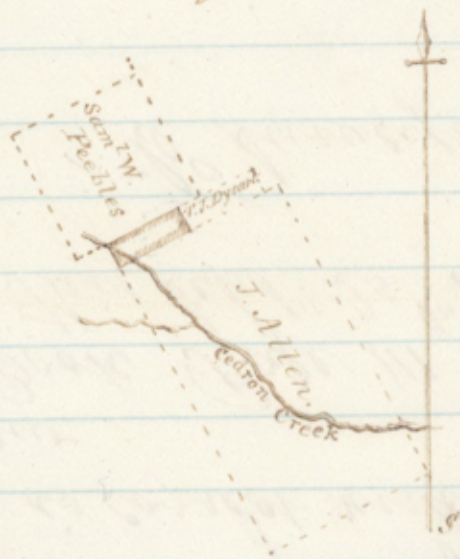

County of Bosque 3rd Field notes of a Survey
of 160 acres of land made for Mr. J. M. Allister,
it being the land to which he is entitled
by virtue of Pre-emption Certificate, issued
by Geo James, Ck. Dist. C. P. Co. on the 18th
Sept^r. AD 1873. Said land is situated on
the head waters of Cedron, about $\frac{6}{8}$ miles
East from the Town of Meridian



Beginning at the S. W. Corner of Dypart's
Pre-emption, from which a Live oak marked
T bears N 52 E 2000 rs for the S. E. corner of
this Survey.

Running thence S 60 W 1460 varas to
Cedron Creek, 1700 varas to the S. W. corner,
with Allen's W. W. corner.

Thence N 30 W 3320 rs in the bed
of Cedron Creek; the W. W. Corner of this
Survey, from which a Walnut bears
N 19 E 1000 rs, and another bears N 47 W 1000

Thence N60E 1700 ors to the N.E. corner,
a mound of rocks in prairie (also the
N.W. corner of Dyars' Survey) in line of
Peebles Survey.
