the said Smith arrived in this Republic

and that *he* is a *Man of Color* and entitled to *One League*

and One Labor of land, upon the condition of paying at the rate of *Seven Dollars* — for every labor of Irrigable land *Five Dollars*

for every labor of temporal or arable land *Two Dollars and forty cents*

for every labor of pasture land which may be contained in the survey secured to *him or his* by this certificate.

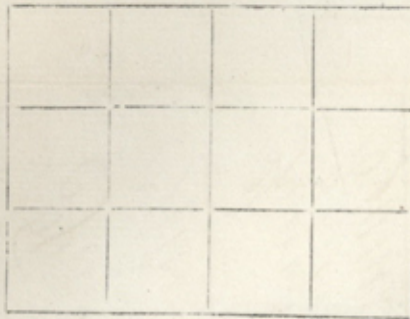

Clerk of the District Court of San Augustine County
by holding sessions in and for the said County. do
hereby certify that David O Warren who sued
as the assignee of Simus Smith upon a certifi-
cate issued to the said David O Warren as assignee
of Simus Smith. by the Board of Land Com-
missioners of San Augustine County. being
number Three Hundred and Two. (No 302) and
dated. 12th February AD 1838. for One League
and One Labor of Land as an Emigrant to
Texas previous to March 3^d 1836 and as a married man
which said Certificate was not recommended for
Patent by the local and Travelling Board of Land
Commissioners for San Augustine County under
an act of Congress passed 29th January 1840
and that he recovered of the State of Texas at
the April Term. of the said District Court of San
Augustine County. Eighteen Hundred and Forty seven
upon a verdict of a jury duly empanelled there-
in. a judgment against the said State of Texas
for One League and One Labor of Land under the
act entitled an act supplementary to an act to
detect fraudulent Land Certificates and to pro-
vide for issuing patents to legal claimants of
ground 4th February AD 1841
