and surveyed for *L. Huse* on the *28<sup>th</sup>* day of *March* 187*2* by *L. H. Scutchfield* a Surveyor of

said County, ; that he has occupied and improved the same as a Homestead for a period of three consecutive years, beginning on the *28<sup>th</sup>* day of *March* 18*72*

that he is *a married man* and that he makes this affidavit for the purpose of obtaining a title to the same for a Homestead, under an Act supplementary to "An Act for the Benefit of Actual Occupants of the Public Lands," approved May 26th, 1873, and Acts prior thereto; and that he has not a Homestead other than the above.

AND also at the same time came and personally appeared *C. O. Strand* and *John Christianson* two credible resident citizens of said County, to me well known, who being duly sworn, depose and say that *L. Huse*

the person first above named in this Affidavit, has actually settled upon and cultivated as a Homestead, the land surveyed for him on the *28<sup>th</sup>* day of *March* 187*2* by the Surveyor aforesaid, for the period of three years, and they nor either of them have any interest in the said land.
