 Brazos River, a Cottonwood 18 inches in diameter marked D
 at the S.E. corner of this Survey - Thence S. 60° W. 5444 to
 the S.W. corner of this Survey, a Stake, in the North line of
 said Chapman Survey - Thence N. 30° W. 752 to the
 N.W. corner, a Stake. Thence N. 50° E. 752 to a corner in
 the West line of a 738 acre Survey made for J. S. Smith -
 Thence S. 30° E. 221 to a corner - Thence N. 60° E. 4692 to
 the West bank of the Brazos for the N.E. corner -
 Thence S. 30° E. down Brazos with its meanderings
