Presents that I - I N Matray  
of the State of Texas and County of Bosque  
for and in Consideration of the sum  
of Two hundred Dollars - to me in hand  
paid by Henrik Dahl of the State and  
County aforesaid the receipt whereof is  
hereby acknowledged - have bargained  
and sold and by these Presents Convey  
and Confirm unto the said Henrik Dahl

all my right title interest in  
a certain parcel of Land containing  
Three hundred and twenty acres  
(320) Situated on or near a Creek  
or Stream Known as Nills Creek  
in Bosque County acquired by me  
the said I N Matray by virtue of  
my Settlement thereon in the Month  
of April 1853 - under the law of the  
State of Texas granting Preemption  
privileges to actual Settlers - by  
which authority it was surveyed for  
me by the Surveyor - of B Erath of  
Milam Land district, and under  
which grant and authority I hold  
possession of said premises up to this  
time

Labouring on and improving the same  
and now I the said J M Matray  
convey the right and interest acquired  
by me under said Settlement and  
Survey - unto the said Henrik Dahl  
his Heirs and assigns with all  
benefits therefrom arising and all  
privileges thereto belonging for the  
said Henrik Dahl to carry out and fulfill  
all the conditions and requisites  
to be complied with according to  
law - to enable a Patent to issue  
for said Land - which said Henrik Dahl  
or his assigns are authorized to  
receive in his own Proper Name  
warranting and defending and  
defending the said claim and  
right so far obtained by me from  
myself and heirs unto said Henrik Dahl  
his heirs and assigns for ever  
hereafter in testimony whereof I  
hereunto set my hand and seal  
using a servant for a seal
