Beginning at the N.E. corner of a survey in the name of Gustave Earl and running from thence S. 30 E. 770 varas to a corner for this survey a stake from which a line cut bears N. 85 E. 90 varas thence N. 60 E. 1121 varas to the S.E. corner of this survey from which a line cut marked V bears S. 85 E. 40 varas and a span marked W bears S. 6 1/2 E. 45 varas thence N. 30 W. 1315 varas to the N.E. corner from which a line cut marked V bears S. 6 1/2 E. 40 varas thence S. 60 W. 1696 varas to the NW corner a stake in the line of a survey in the name of Compton thence S. 30 E. 545 varas to said Compton's S.E. corner thence N. 60 E. with the line of Gustave Earl 575 varas to the beginning.
