McBurny - of the same State and County - the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged - have bargained and sold and by these presents convey and confirm unto C. C. McBurny all my right title and interest in a certain parcel of Land containing 3.18 - Acres, Situated on the waters of Neils Creek in Bosque County acquired by me the said William McBurny - by virtue of my Settlement thereon in the Month of June in the 8th day AD 1853 Under the law of the State of Texas granting Preemption Privileges to actual Settlers - by which Authority it was Surveyed for me by G. W. Erath a Deputy Surveyor for Milam Land District on the 10th day of July AD 1853 and under which grant and authority I held Possession of said Premises up to this time having thereon Houses and a Field and now I the said William McBurny convey the rights & issues acquired under said Settlement and Survey unto the said C. C. McBurny his heirs and assigns with all

A benefits. - and issues therefrom arising
and all privileges thereto belonging
for the said C. B. McBurny to carry
out and fulfill all conditions
subsequent to be complied with
according to law, to enable a Patent
to issue for said Land which the
said C. B. McBurny - or his heirs
are authorized to receive in
his or their own proper name or
names - Fully warranting and defend-
- ing the said claim and right
so far - obtained by me - from
myself and by heirs or any person
claiming the same by through
or under me - unto the said
C. B. McBurny - his heirs and
assigns for ever - hereafter


