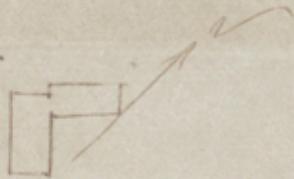

unto Paul Poulson all the Right
Title and interest I have in and to
a certain tract of land situated
on the waters of Gary Creek in said
County containing 318 acres acquired
by me by virtue of my settlement
thereon under the laws of this State
granting preemption privileges to actual
-al settlers on the public Domain and
was surveyed by G. B. Erath Deputy
Surveyor for Milam Land District
on the 15th day of February 1854
under which grant and survey I
I have lived upon improved and
cultivated the same up to this
time and did on the 10th day of

march 1857 make the proof Required
by law before the clerk of the County
Court to entitle me to a certificate
which certificate will accompany
this transfer Now I the said Helton
bind myself my heirs and assigns
to warrant and defend the title
of said land against the claims
of myself my heirs and assigns
to the said Paul Poulson his heirs
and assigns the said Poulson is to have
and enjoy all the benefits therefrom
arising and all the privileges thereto
belonging as Rightful owner of the
same and to receive a patent in
his own proper name and the com=
missioner of the general Land office
is authorized and Requested to issue
to the said Paul Poulson a patent
when he shall have paid the sum
of ten Dollars for the use of the State
and the patent fee In Testimony where
