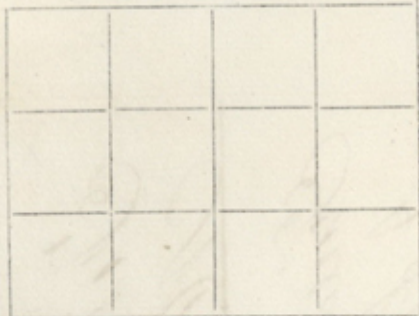

Beginning at a stake in the back line of the Sarah Hensley league being the North Corner of Survey No 115 with the name of Willis Roberts. Thence N 30 W with said Hensley line 313 varas, crosses the North Cearon 1060 varas, the South line of Wisley Fishers survey Thence S 60 W 317 varas, a Pile of stones on Clay Bluff 20 varas, east of the North bank of the Cearon the S.W. Corner of W. Fishers League Thence N 30 W. 103 varas to a Station in the line of W. Fishers league for corner Thence S 60 W 2818 varas to the N.E. line of A. Meuschaefer survey Thence S 30 E 1163 varas to a Stone mound from which a Live Oak marked J bears N 39 E 29 varas, and another Live Oak marked A bears S 58 E 31 varas Thence N 60 E 580 varas, again Spring Branch 2 varas, North of the line 672 varas at Pile of Stone a Live Oak marked J bears N 42 W. 16 1/10 varas, and an Elm marked A bears S 27 W. 24 varas at 758 varas passes the Northern west corner of Survey No 117. 3135
