Proof of Settlement under Homestead Act.

The State of Texas, }

County of Bosque }

Before Me, the undersigned District Clerk in and for the County aforesaid, this day came and personally appeared ms. Jane Auldridge, a resident citizen of said County, who being by me duly sworn, declares that she is a bona fide settler upon 160 acres of vacant public land, situated in said County, and surveyed for her on the 14th day of April 1874, by William Macaulay, a Surveyor of said County; that she has occupied and improved the same as a Homestead for a period of three consecutive years, beginning on the January day of 1870, that she is a married woman, and that she makes this affidavit for the purpose of obtaining a title to the same for a Homestead, under an Act supplementary to "An Act for the Benefit of Actual Occupants of the Public Lands," approved May 26th, 1873, and Acts prior thereto; and that she has not a Homestead other than the above.

AND, also, at the same time came and personally appeared E. R. Spencer and John R. H. Spencer, two credible resident citizens of said County, to me well known, who being duly sworn, depose and say that ms. Jane Auldridge, the person first above named in this affidavit, has actually settled upon and cultivated as a Homestead, the land surveyed for her on the 14th day of April 1874, by the Surveyor aforesaid, for the period of three years, and they, nor either of them, have any interest in the said land.
