

County of Bosque on the Water of Red River about 14 miles S 45 E from Meridian  
Beginning at the S.E. corner of the next western survey in the name of C. H. Pigg  
marked from which a Cottonwood marked I bears N 27 W. 78 varas, and a Small Grove of Elm, bears S 85 E  
Thence N 30 W. 950 varas to said Elm by northeast corner  
Thence S 60 W. 1240 varas to the N. <sup>line</sup> ~~corner~~ of the L. R. Owen Survey
