for Thos. Caulfield it being the  
quantity of land to which he is entitled  
by virtue of compliance with an  
Act passed of the Legislature passed  
Aug. 26<sup>th</sup> 1856 authorizing the Settle-  
ment Location of the Miss. and  
Pacific Rail Road Road, as app-  
ears by the attached affidavits made  
before J. H. Scutchfield Feb. 15<sup>th</sup> day  
1857 and marked A & B. Said land  
is situated <sup>in Bosque County 19 miles S. 52<sup>nd</sup> E. from Mexicians</sup> on Childers Creek eight  
miles above its junction with the Brazos  
River

Beginning 2350 as S. 60<sup>th</sup> W. from  
the S.W. corner of the Walter Davis 1900  
acre survey for the S.E. corner of this  
survey from which an Elm marked  
B bears N. 63<sup>rd</sup> E. 29 varas and a Live  
Oak marked A bears N. 55<sup>th</sup> E. 30 varas.  
Thence S. 60<sup>th</sup> W. 700 varas crossed Chil-  
ders Creek, 251 varas to the S.W. corner  
from which a Spanish oak marked  
C bears N. 63<sup>rd</sup> W. 20 varas. Thence N. 60<sup>th</sup> W.  
25 varas Childers Creek 250 varas  
to the N.W. corner in Prairie Thence S. 60<sup>th</sup> E.  
250 varas to the S.E. corner in Prairie  
Thence S. 30<sup>th</sup> E. 250 varas to the beginning
