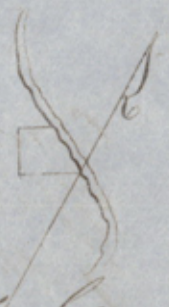

 of 160 acres of land made for  
 A. J. King it being the quantity of land  
 to which he is entitled by virtue of  
 compliance with an act of the Legisla-  
 ture passed August 26<sup>th</sup> 1856 to author-  
 ize the Location and settlement of  
 the Miss. and Pacific Rail Road  
 Reserve as appears by the attached  
 Affidavits marked No 13; situated  
 in Bexar County

on the west side of the Brazos River  
 below the mouth of Ocean creek  
 about 40 miles S. S. E. from Meridian  
 Beginning at the N. E. corner of  
 the Ann Wheelock Seaman for the  
 S. E. corner of this survey. Thence  
 up the River meandering the  
 same N 58 W 1078 varas to the N. E.  
 corner from which a Post Elder marked  
 A bears S 15 E 5 varas and another marked  
 X bears S 30 E 3 varas Thence S 60 W 707 varas  
 to the N. W. corner from which a Lin  
 oak marked D bears N 85 E 50 varas  
 Thence S 30 E 950 varas to the S. W. corner  
 from which a Black Jack marked O bears  
 S 70 W 3 varas and a Lin oak marked
