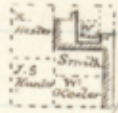

Clerks decided that there was no
Land vacant only a small piece
on the N.E. side of the Gester
Surv. Now the question is, if I
have a Resurvey by the County

is a man by the name of Wm. Alsop
is aiming to Preempt that part
lying between the J.B. Barry &
Wm. Henley Surveys - and prob-
