The State of Texas³ Filed notes of
County of Bosque³ a survey of 160
acres of land made for Daniel Robinson
it being the quantity of land to which is
entitled by virtue of compliance with
an act of the Legislature passed Aug.
26th 1856 "to authorise the Location, sale
and settlement of the Miss. & Pacific
Rail Road, as appears by the attached
Affidavits dated February the
day 1857 and marked A¹⁰⁴ said
land is situated on a branch of Little
dry creek about 4 miles from the
Brazos River and 20 miles SSW from Meridian

Beginning at the S.E. corner
of a Survey made in the name of
Thos Caulfield for the S.W. corner of
this survey from which an Elm marked
B bears N 63¹/₂ E 29 varas and a live oak
marked A bears N 55 E 30 varas thence
N 60 E 950 varas to the S.E. corner from
which a live oak marked P bears N 15 W 44
varas and another marked Q bears
N 35 E 20 varas thence N 50 W 950 varas
crossing a branch to the N.E. corner from
which an Elm marked R bears S 78 W
8 varas and another marked S bears
S 75 E 10 varas thence S 60 W 40 varas
crossing a branch 950 varas to the S.W.
corner in Prairie thence S 30 E 950 varas
to the beginning surveyed January 20th 1858
