of the assigned premises

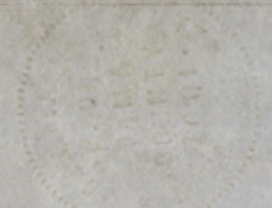

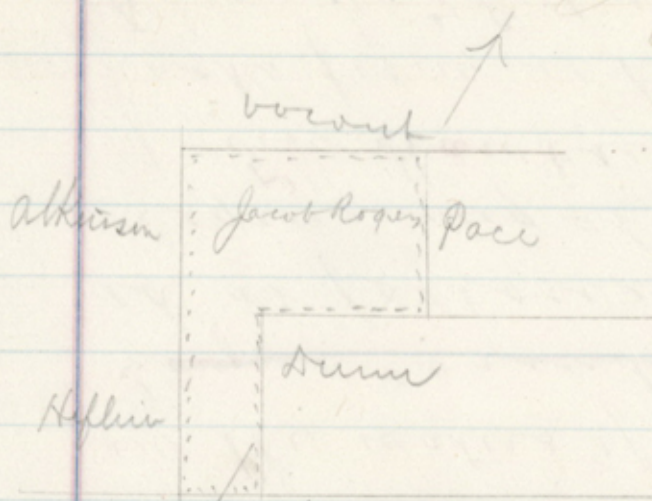
