County of Basque } of 100 acres of Land
made for John S. Clark it being the
quantity of Land to which he is entitled to by virtue
of compliance with an act of the Legislature
passed August 26th 1856 to Authorize the Location
Sale and Settlement of the Mississippi & Pacific Rail
Road Reserve as claimed by the Atlantic & Pacific
dated Feb. 23rd 1857 and marked No. - Said Land
is located on the Wm Fisher League 3½ miles from
the Pecos River, ~~in~~ Basque County about 11 miles N.E. from Marathon,
beginning at the SW corner of a Survey made in the
name of S. F. Sparks, thence 160 N 660 varas for the SE
corner of this Survey from which a Live Oak marked
H bears N 16° W 84° varas and a Yellow Marke & bears
S 10° E 89 varas thence N 30 W 950 varas to the NE corner from
which a Black Jack 3 inches in diameter bears N 65° E 25
varas thence N 60 W 950 varas to the NW corner from which
a Lim Oak marked X bears S 22 W 50 varas & another
4 inches in diameter bears N 44 W 26 varas. Then N
S 30 E 850 varas crop branch 950 varas to the SW corner
from which a Ocean Marke H bears N 80 W 8
varas thence N 60 E 950 varas to the Beginning.
