Road Reserve as appears by the attached Affidavits
dated Feb, 28th 1857 and marked No. - Said Land
is Located on the Mrs Fisher League 3 3/4 Miles from
the Brazos River, ~~in~~ Bosque County about 11 miles N. 73. E. from ~~the~~ beginning
beginning at the S W Corner of a Survey made in the
name of S F Sparks, thence S 60 W 660 varas for the S E
Corner of this Survey from which a Line East marked
H bears N 16 1/2 W 84 1/2 varas and a hollow marked + bears
S 10 1/2 E 89 varas thence N 30 W 950 varas to the N E Corner from
which a Black Jack 3 inches in diameter bears N 65 E 35
varas thence N 60 W 950 varas to the N W corner from which
a Line East marked x bears S 24 W 50 varas and another
4 inches in diameter bears N 47 W 46 varas thence
S 30 E 850 varas cross Branch 950 varas to the S W corner
from which a Pecan marked H bears N 80 W 4
varas thence N 60 E 950 varas to the Beginning.
