

Hartley of the County and State aforesaid, have granted, bargained, transferred, and assigned and do hereby grant, bargain, sell, transfer and assign unto the said Hartley all of my right title and interest in and to my certain unconditional certificate of land right for three thousand and twenty acres of land No 8 issued to me by the County Court of the County of Galveston on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of February A.D. 1855 in lieu of the Conditional certificate heretofore issued to me by the Board of Land Commissioners in said County dated March 30<sup>th</sup> 1841, hereby confirming unto the said Hartley his heirs and assigns the use, ownership and title to the said certificate, free from the claims of any person or persons whatsoever claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
