To all to whom these Presents shall come, know ye,

I, J. R. Lubbock GOVERNOR of the STATE aforesaid, by virtue of the power vested in me by LAW, and in accordance with the LAWS of said STATE, in such case made and provided, do, by these presents, GRANT to the heirs of Edward Sobrinity deceased, their heirs or assigns, FOREVER, Three hundred and twenty Acres of LAND, situated and described as follows:

det. 320 acres

In Bosque County on the waters of Rocky Creek about 13 miles S. 83° E. of Meridian, and known as Survey No 134, in District No 1. by virtue of Certificate No  $\frac{2641}{2742}$  issued by the Commissioner of the General Land Office on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of December 1852, for the unlocated balance of Certificate No 119 issued by the Board of Land Commissioners of Harris County on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of December 1857. Beginning at the S. E. Corner of E. Burch's preemption a State, from which a Live Oak marked B bears N. 25° W. 28 vars. Thence N. 30° W. 950 vars to said Burch's N. E. Corner, a State, from which a Live Oak marked C, bears North 31 vars, another marked D bears N. 7° E. 34 vars, 1254 vars to a stake and mound on the line of Gertrudes Leirino's survey. Thence N. 60° E. 1452 vars with said line. Thence S. 30° E. 1235 vars to a stake and mound, on the N. line of Am Wheelocks survey. Thence N 59 1/4 W. with said line, 1453 vars to the beginning.


