To all to whom these Presents shall come, know ye,

I, J. R. Lubbeck GOVERNOR of the STATE aforesaid, by virtue of the power vested in me by LAW, and in accordance with the LAWS of said STATE, in such case made and provided, do, by these presents, GRANT to Harvey R. Marks his heirs or assigns, FOREVER, Three Hundred and Twenty Acres of LAND, situated and described as follows:

Harvey R. Marks
320 acres

In Bosque County, on the waters of Chilians Creek, about 1 1/2 miles S. 54° E from Meridian, and known as survey No 139, in District No 1 by virtue of unconditional Headright Certificate, issued by the District Court of Harris County January 26th 1860. Beginning at the S. E. corner of the Joel Keith survey, a stake and mound. Thence N. 60° E. 2184 vars to a stake and mound. Thence N. 30° W. 829 vars to a stake and mound. Thence S. 60° W. 2184 vars to a stake and mound. Thence S. 30° E. 829 vars to the place of beginning.



