To all to whom these Presents shall come, know ye,

I, *J. W. Throckmorton* GOVERNOR of the STATE aforesaid, by virtue

of the power vested in me by LAW, and in accordance with the LAWS of said STATE, in such case made and provided, do, by these presents, GRANT to *John D. Chamberlain*

his heirs or assigns, FOREVER, *Three Hundred and Twenty* acres of LAND, situated and described as follows:

*John D. Chamberlain
320 Acres*

In Bague County on the head of Childers creek about 7 miles S. 76° E. of Meridian, known as survey N° 144 in District N° 1. by virtue of Certificate N° 116 issued by the Board of Land Commissioners of Galveston County June 25th 1845.


