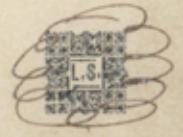
KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, *Jose Arcega*

Arcega for and in consideration of the sum of *Twenty five* dollars, to me in hand paid, the receipt whereof

is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold, transferred and set over, and so far as the ability in me exists, delivered possession of, to *John D. Chamberlain* his heirs and assigns forever *Six Hundred and forty* acres of unlocated land, to which I am entitled as a Head-Right, in the Republic of Texas, by virtue of a Certificate, No. *100* issued by the Board of Land Commissioners for the County of Galveston, dated the *second* day of *June 1845*, and hereunto annexed. And, I authorise the said *John D. Chamberlain* to locate said land in any part of Texas he may think proper; and to call upon the proper Officer, who is hereby authorised to issue to the said *John D. Chamberlain* the necessary title to the same. And I further authorise the said *John D. Chamberlain* his heirs or assigns to enter upon, when located, said land, to use, enjoy, and likewise to dispose of the same, as his own property, acquired by a good and lawful title, and likewise to do all things necessary in the premises towards getting a patent from the Government.

This is to certify that José Ortega has appeared before us the board of Land Commissioners for the County of Galveston and proving to us according to law that he arrived in this country in the month of April A^d 1839th that he has resided in this country three years and performed all the duties requiring of him as a citizen, that he is a married man and is entitled to an unconditional grant of six hundred and forty acres of land in accordance with an act of Congress approved the 18th day of January A^d 1843
