resaid. this day came and person-

ally appeared Christian O Strand a resi-
-dent citizen of said County who being
by me duly sworn, declares that he is a
Bona Fide settler upon one hundred and
sixty acres of Vacant public Land
situated in said County and surveyed
for Christian O Strand on the 8 day
of December 1867 by Ward Keeler
Surveyor of said County, that he
has occupied and improved the same
as a homestead for the period of
three consecutive years, beginning
on the 8th day of December 1867
that he is a head of a family and
that he makes this affidavit for the
purpose of obtaining a title to the same
for a homestead under an Act
Supplementary to "An Act to regulate
the Disposal of the public Lands
of the State of Texas" Approved
March 24th 1871 and that he has
not a homestead other than the above

And also at the same time
came and personally appeared
O. Smenson and O. P. Fop Two
Credible resident citizens of said

County. To me well known who
being duly sworn, depose and say
that Christian O Strand the person
first above named in this affidavit
has actually settled upon and
cultivated as a homestead the
Land surveyed for him on the
