1868 that his is the head of a family and  
that he makes this affidavit for the pur-  
-pose of obtaining a title to the same for a  
homestead under an act supplementary  
to an act to regulate the disposal of the  
Public Lands of the State of Texas "Appro-  
-ved March 21 1871 and that he has  
not a homestead other than the above  
And also at the same time came  
and personally appeared G. A. Nygaard  
and P. Pederson two credible resident  
Citizens of said County & are well known  
who being duly sworn depose and say  
that Solve Krudson the person first  
above named in this affidavit has  
actually settled upon and cultivated  
as a homestead the Land surveyed for
